The children will be securing their knowledge of number and place value and applying these skills in various mathematical situations.

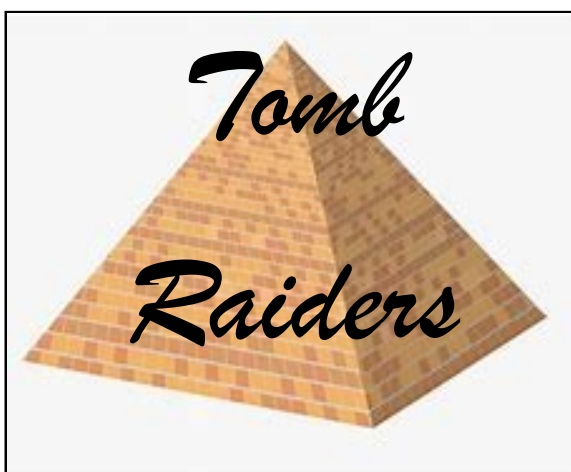
Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will be focusing on these four operations and looking at various methods used in each operation.
