Poetry – exploring form

RE

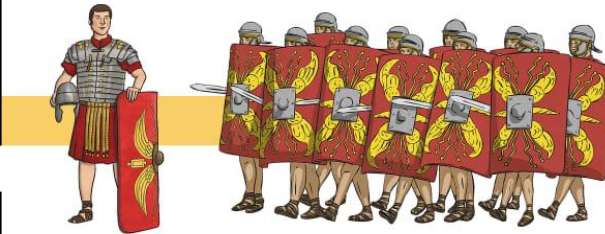
A look at religions within our neighbourhood and how settlers have encouraged a multicultural society.

Topics covered will include, number, place value, calculation, decimals and fractions, measures and statistics. Focus will be:

- Time and money

Music
