The Space Homework grid below contains activities which should be completed during the Summer Term. Choose 1 task to do every week and complete it in your book or upload a photo of what you have done to Dojo. I will look at homework each Thursday so please make sure it has been sent in by then. 1 piece of homework is worth 5 Dojos! There will also be a weekly maths activity linked to what we have been learning that week, that should also be completed in the homework book by Thursday each week. Your homework tasks are in addition to reading your school book as often as you can and practising your weekly spellings.

<p>Design and name your very own alien friend.</p> <p>What makes them special? Why would you be their friend? What would you do together? Write a short description.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Ask your adult to take you to a local library.</p> <p>Can you find non-fiction books about space? Can you spot features of a non-fiction book? Put a picture of your favourite non-fiction book about space on Dojo to discuss with the class.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Create a space picture.</p> <p>You could paint a planet, sketch the stars or even use some art and craft materials to create the solar system. Be as creative as possible.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Draw and label the parts of a plant.</p> <p>Using the correct colours, draw and colour a plant you have found. You can then label the parts of the plant (stem, root, leaf, flower, petal).</p> <p>Date completed:</p>
<p>Draw your favourite planet and find out interesting facts to label your picture.</p> <p>Use descriptive sentences and factual statements to label your planet.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Bake off!</p> <p>Find a space themed recipe and make it. E.g. moon rock cakes or star shaped cookies.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Make a list.</p> <p>Write or draw a list of things you will need to take on a space trip E.g. camera, binoculars, helmet, spacesuit, notepad, food etc.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Write a diary about a journey you have been on.</p> <p>Who were you with? Where did you go? What did you see? How did it make you feel?</p> <p>Date completed:</p>
<p>Use 3d shapes around the house to create a model rocket.</p> <p>Share a picture of your model on Dojo and explain the shapes you have used to share with the class.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Which plants grow in your garden?</p> <p>Can you find 4 different plants in your garden (or nearest park if you don't have a garden). Draw them carefully and label them if you know what they are called.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Make up a space dance.</p> <p>You could include different space movements e.g. spin like a planet, twinkle like a star or jump like a rocket. You could put your movements to space themed music such as Fly me to the moon by Frank Sinatra or Rocket Man by Elton John.</p> <p>Date completed:</p>	<p>Research a famous astronaut.</p> <p>Use a book or ask an adult to help you access the internet.
